

2019 Rodeo Tomato - "Harris Moran 8849"



- Big beef style tomato

Instructions for all 4.5" pot tomatoes

- Pot them up in 1-gallon containers for 30 days
- Harden them off
- Plant them inside 4-5' tomato cages
- Anchor the cages
- Wrap with N-Sulate Cloth for wind protection.
- Remove the wrap when the plants start to bloom (pollination)

Bluebonnets

- Plant now. When planting a bluebonnet transplant, be careful not to plant it too deeply. You will notice that all of the leaves arise from a central crown-like structure. This crown should not be buried or the plant will rot
